



## 2026 Season Information

- **Competitive players** (born 2015 and earlier)
- **Non-Competitive players** (born 2016, 2017, 2018, Jan-June 2019)

### Registrations Open:

**Sunday 11 January** Pre-sale for existing Raiders Allstars players – registration link will be emailed to existing members.

**Sunday 18 January** new non-competitive (7 year olds born up to 30 June 2019).

**Sunday 18 January** new players who have registered on the waitlist will be invited to register where caps have not been reached by returning players - links to register will be emailed to new players on the waitlist.

### Registrations Close:

**WHEN SOLD OUT** - registrations will close as soon as age caps are reached. Please register early to avoid disappointment as we are unable to accept registrations above the cap.

### Registration through the Netball Connect system

Registrations will occur online or via the app through Netball Connect, You MUST use the same login details if you have registered previously.

You can register multiple participants in one transaction to avoid multiple transactions fees – there will be an option at the checkout to select + add new participant, located at the top of the page. Please ensure you select **Raiders Allstars Netball Club (Downey Park Netball Association)** from the drop-down list and not another Downey Park or Raiders at Western District. Please be aware there is a surcharge for credit card payments.

### Discount code for non-competitive players.

Due to limitations in Netball Connect we are unable to differentiate prices for non-competitive players and competitive players.

All non-competitive players (7-10 years) will need to input the discount code: **NON-COMPETITIVE** at the payment stage to reduce their fees from **\$475 to \$425**.

**Please ensure you use this code at the time of registration** if you are within that age range, as we are unable to refund this later. Any use of the discount code where the player is not within the relevant age range will result in a registration shortfall and therefore an invalid registration.

## **Players who will also be coaching, umpiring, managing or volunteering (Non-playing membership)**

If you will be coaching, umpiring, managing or volunteering, **you must tick those boxes at the time of registration**. Please ensure you have your current coaching and umpire accreditation information to update in the Netball Connect system e.g. blue card number and expiration, coaching accreditation and expiry and umpire accreditation.

## **Registering a Non-competitive team**

For our Non-competitive players (born 2016, 2017, 2018, Jan-June 2019) we encourage parents to register a whole team to play together. To do this, you must have 9 players, your own coach and a nominated team manager. All players must be registered before registration closes. The complete team list, including coach and manager name, must be sent, by the team manager only, to [nsg\\_raiders@outlook.com](mailto:nsg_raiders@outlook.com) by 31 January 2026.

If there are less than 9 players in a group and/or no coach, we place players as any individual players register. We endeavour to keep friends who want to play together in the same team, however this cannot be guaranteed due to player numbers. ## **Registration fees**

Full payment is required at the time of registration. Season costs are listed below, with a full breakdown available on the [Raiders website](#).

**\*\*Use discount code NON-COMPETITIVE at the payment stage for 7-10 years to reduce fees from \$475 to \$425.**

## **Proof of birth date**

All new players under 18 years of age will need to provide a proof of birth date document to the manager of the team. All managers will record the details and provide these to the club.

## **Queensland Government Play On! Sports Vouchers (formally known as Fair Play Vouchers)**

Play On! Sports Vouchers are financial assistance provided by the Government and are designed for children from families who are least able to afford to participate in club sport. There is a specific application process and eligibility is verified.

**N.B The vouchers must be obtained before registering with Raiders Allstars, vouchers cannot be redeemed after registration with Raiders.**

If you are a returning player and you receive your Play On! voucher after the returning player registration closes, please contact the Raiders registrars to reserve your daughter's place at Raiders Allstars.

More information is available on the Queensland Government website. Please do not choose the Play On! discount in the registration form unless you have received a voucher from the Queensland Government as this will result in a registration fee shortfall and your registration will be invalid.

### **What happens after I register?**

Once you register in Netball Connect and have paid fees in full (this includes submitting your Play On! Sports voucher to the Raiders Treasurer), you will be allocated a place in Raiders Allstars Netball Club – every player will be placed in a team.

If you are a competitive player, you will be required to attend trials in order to be allocated to a team (see below). If you are a non-competitive player, Raiders Allstars will email you with your team and coach.

### **Trials**

All competitive players (born 2015 and earlier), are expected to attend every trial session. Trials will take place at Downey Park netball courts on the following dates:

**11s – 13s Trial dates:** Sunday 8 February | 15 February | 22 February

**Cadets / Inters Trial dates :** Wednesday 4 February | 11 February | 18 February | 25 February

**Opens Trial date:** Wednesday 18 February (Trial)

If you would like to be considered for selection into **Opens Division 1 or 2**, **attendance on this trial date is mandatory.**

Players wishing to play in lower Opens divisions/social teams may nominate to be paper graded instead of attending the trial. Paper grading means that previous playing history and preferred positions will determine team allocation.

**ACTION:** Please email Senior Registrar at [senior\\_registrar\\_raiders@outlook.com](mailto:senior_registrar_raiders@outlook.com) to let us know whether you intend to trial or be paper graded.

**Opens Round Robin:** Wednesday 25 February (attendance mandatory for **ALL Opens players**).

The time of trials is dependent on age group and will be finalised and communicated to all players and updated on the [Raiders website](#) and Facebook page, closer to the trial dates.

## Training

Training will be on Wednesday nights.

**10s and 11s teams only** will commence training on Wednesday 11<sup>th</sup> March to prepare for the Grading Day on 21<sup>st</sup> March (see below).

Training will commence on **Wednesday 18<sup>th</sup> March 2026 for all other teams.**

Training times are usually 5-6pm, 6-7pm, 7-8pm. Generally, the younger players will train earliest, but exact training times are subject to coach and court availability. Training times will be advised once coaches have been allocated to teams and availability of courts and coaches determined.

## 10s and 11s Grading Day

DPNA will be hosting a grading day for the 10s and 11s teams on **Saturday 21<sup>st</sup> March** at DPNA courts, commencing at 8am. All 10s and 11s teams are expected to attend.

## Games at Downey Park

All players will play fixtures on Saturdays. The first game for all teams will be on 2<sup>nd</sup> May 2026. Non-competitive will play their last game on 22nd August 2026, Round 14. Junior and Senior competitive teams have finals scheduled between 29th August to 12th September 2026. Please consider these dates if booking holidays around this time.

Playing times cannot be requested, these are decided by DPNA. DPNA will publish the draw on the 22nd April 2026.
